

## U.S. State Privacy Notice

**Updated and Effective as of: June 24, 2026**

This U.S. State Privacy Notice supplements the Prescriptive Health, Inc. Privacy Policy and applies to residents of states with applicable consumer privacy laws. Residents of certain states, including California, may have additional privacy rights under applicable law. Depending on your state of residence and subject to certain legal limitations and exceptions, you may have the right to:

- request access to Personal Information we maintain about you;
- request correction of inaccurate Personal Information;
- request deletion of Personal Information;
- obtain a portable copy of certain Personal Information;
- opt out of targeted advertising, profiling, or certain sharing activities;
- limit certain uses of sensitive Personal Information where applicable;
- appeal our denial of a privacy rights request.

We may collect and process categories of Personal Information including:

- internet and device activity information;
- geolocation information;
- professional or employment-related information;
- inferences and preferences;
- and certain sensitive Personal Information, including health-related information where applicable.

We may use and disclose Personal Information for purposes including:

- providing and improving our Services;
- customer support and communications;
- analytics and website functionality;
- security and fraud prevention;
- legal compliance;
- and marketing and advertising activities.

We do not sell Personal Information for monetary consideration.
